#### **Christmas Nativities**

The school invites parents/carers and families to 'The Big Big Story' Nativity performed on Tuesday 12th December and 13th December 2023 at 1.30pm in the school hall. Tickets will be on sale on Parent Pay, at a cost of £3, from 27th November 2023.

Families will initially be permitted to request a maximum of 3 tickets in total per family. Only one day can be selected during the first week of ticket sales. Extra tickets which have not been purchased will be offered to all families on a first come basis from 4th December 2023. Primary 1-3 are leading the Nativity. Primary 4-7 are supporting the Nativity and performing their own selection of Christmas songs to entertain their guests. If there are any family members attending either Nativity who require assisted arrangements, please inform the school by Wednesday 6th December 2023. We remind parents/carers that prams and buggies cannot be taken into the school hall for these events for Health and Safety reasons. We looking forward to welcoming families to our Christmas celebrations.

#### **Christmas Disco**

Time to look out some Christmas Disco outfits. The school aims to fund a DJ for the Christmas Disco on Thursday 14th December 2023. The Primary 1-4 disco will be held from 5.45 to 6.45pm. The Primary 5-7 disco will be held from 7.00-8.00pm. Children must be dropped off and collected by an adult over the age of 16. Dancing moves at the ready!
